# A classic matchup between storied franchises

In what looks to be a Fall Classic for the ages, two of baseball's most celebrated franchises meet in the postseason for the first time since the 1916 World Series.

The Red Sox won the Series in five games. They are now looking for a fourth World Series title since 2004 after ending an 86-year drought that year. Boston is making its first Series appearance since defeating St. Louis in 2013. The Dodgers return to World Series after losing Game 7 at home against Houston last season.

They are looking for their first championship in 30 years — since Kirk Gibson, Orel Hershiser and Tommy Lasorda brought home the 1988 crown. The last time the Dodgers reached back-to-back World Series, they lost to Yankees in 1977 and '78. Both Los Angeles and Boston are loaded with stars, have plenty of depth and will platoon at several positions to gain favorable matchups. Boston opens as a slight favorite.

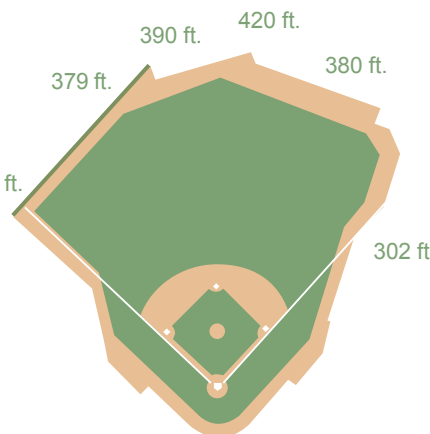
