

REWARD \$1,500.00



Mohave Silent Witness has offered a reward of \$1,500.00 for anyone with information leading to the arrest of the driver involved in a fatal hit and run collision that occurred on April 23, 2019. At approximately 10:55 PM, deputies responded to the area of Colorado Rd. and Brook Dr. in Golden Valley for a call of a subject in the roadway. Deputies responded and found the victim, Krisandrea Lynn Pannell-Cashen, 62 of Golden Valley, was deceased on arrival. After a thorough investigation, detectives determined the vehicle involved was possibly a gold in color 1999-2004 Chevy S10 pickup or blazer type vehicle. On April 24, 2019, the suspected vehicle was located abandoned in a wash on the western end of Golden Valley. Detectives responded to the scene, processed the vehicle, and found significant evidence to link the vehicle with the collision. Detectives determined the vehicle was towed to the desert area by an unknown private party. At this time, we are reaching out to the community to identify the unknown person who towed the vehicle, as well as the driver of the vehicle at the time of the collision.

Detectives are also attempting to make contact with the registered owner of the vehicle, identified as Joseph Lloyd Whybark, 34 of Golden Valley, for questions regarding the vehicle.
