First is the selection of queens to represent the Mohave County Fair, and to participate in other community activities throughout the year. Equally important is the opportunity for all the contestants to develop or enhance qualities of leadership, self-confidence, poise, & public speaking abilities.

***Mandatory pageant entry fee payable to Mohave County Fair – \$40 (non-refundable)**

***Registration Deadline – August 30, 2019 (or until all spots are filled)**

Date & Time of Pageant: September 12, 2019 at 5:00pm

Location: Mohave County Fairgrounds

Pageant Cost: \$40 mandatory pageant entry fee. \$10 optional talent entry fee.



Pageant Divisions, Attire, & Prizes

Young Miss – Age 5-8

Junior Miss – Age 9-12

Teen Miss – Age 13-16

Miss – Age 17-22

*Division determined by age on pageant day (be prepared to show proof of age.) Contestants must reside in Mohave County.

*Division Queens win title, trophy, crown, sash, flowers, & admission tickets for 4 plus parking pass.

*Three Runner-ups per division win a trophy. *All participants earn a ribbon.

*Contestants receive a free admission ticket and one parking pass which will be mailed to them in advance.

*All spectators pay an admission fee of \$4 ages 4 - 11, \$7 for 12+

*Miss Mohave County Fair Queen Winners from the past year may not compete – they will crown their successors.

Evening Gown

Each contestant will choose an evening gown to wear for this competition. The gown should represent your personal style and be age appropriate. The judges are looking for your on-stage presence, poise, confidence, grace, beauty and style. They are not looking for a gown- they are looking for the girl in the gown. Choose something that compliments your body and your personality.

On-Stage Interview

Contestants will all come onstage one division at a time wearing their evening gown. Each will individually be asked at least two questions from a pre-prepared list. They will then answer the question to the best of their ability. The list of questions to practice per division is available.

Optional Talent Competition

In addition to mandatory evening gown & onstage questions there will also be an optional pageant talent competition for contestants who wish to enter.

*Talent Divisions: Ages 5-12 + Ages 13-22 *\$10.00 optional talent entry fee payable to Mohave County Fair

Optional Pageant Workshop & Final Registration Day

August 30, 2019 there will be an optional pageant workshop & registration at All Starz Academy – 2634 Airway Ave. in Kingman, AZ. The workshop will run from 1:30-3:00. Contestants are welcome to come & go anytime during that time frame. We will practice evening gown pageant walks and go over how on-stage questions work.

- Tell us 3 things you can't wait to do when you grow up and why?
- If you could be famous what would you like to be famous for?



Teen Miss – Age 13-16

- What one thing do you cherish in life?
- Describe yourself in three characteristics.
- Who do you think is an important role model for children today?
- What quality do you possess that sets you apart from any other contestant?
- What saying or phrase would you like to see used more in today's world and why?
- What is one specific goal you have set for yourself?

Miss – Age 17-22

- What is the biggest problem facing your generation today?
- If you could live in the past, present, or future, which would you choose and why?
- What has been your most proud achievement so far?
